Highlights of the changes include updates and clarification on:

- * Landowner consent
- * Reclamation obligations & drilling waste management, including procedures for fluid assessment & disposal option(s).
- * Site & Soil characteristics for sump construction
- * Requirements for reuse of a sump, disclosure requirements for existing sumps.
- * Management of cement returns
- * Pipeline (boring) drilling waste management; storage & disposal
- * Biodegradation techniques for hydrocarbon-based wastes
- * Notification and information retention requirements, including landfill and deep-well disposal facilities.



Chinook Environmental Services Ltd's operations and management have reviewed the draft and are providing feedback and recommendations to the government in regards to identified flaws or lack of clarification on particulars.
